Facilities Updates

Roof (P. Wegrzynowicz)

- Merely bringing roof up to current code will dramatically improve energy savings. Trying to improve roof beyond code may not be cost effective.
- P. Wegrzynowicz is pursuing getting architect to describe roof specifications in order to get bids.

LED Lighting (P. Wegrzynowicz)

- Rough estimate to replace current fixtures with LED lighting is \$62,000. Potentially, this could help realize a 7% (\$10,000) savings in energy costs annually. Rebates or grants may be available.

MLK DAY Planning

MLK Day planning has begun! We are starting earlier this year and have invited Greg Smith from the Farmington Public Schools to offer a perspective. Some great ideas came out of the initial meeting, and we are excited to move forward with them. More details to follow as they get worked out.

We have the opportunity to be featured in the Chamber's *Link Magazine* for September. Sherri Vaughn has secured this opportunity and Sarah will be writing the copy. This is the alternative to not being able to present at the State of the Cities.

Farmington Hills Water Valve Replacement

In August sometime, the Farmington Hills location will need to be closed for a day in order to replace valves to the water meter. The water will need to be shut off and it could take the whole day. When the city attempted to replace our water meter it was noted that the bypass valves around it were rusted and not functional. When they tried using the valves, they wouldn't close properly and when they went to put them back how they were, a valve started to have a small leak. We have blocked off a few days (August 15, 22, 29) in Library Market where no events or rentals were scheduled to give us options to schedule the work.

MML Liability Insurance

We received the renewal for the Liability Insurance coverage. The total cost was \$68,828 plus a \$200 annual membership fee. We will receive a dividend credit of \$5,771. There was a slight increase in cost this year due to an increase in property values of \$2,538,294 and a small rate increase for the MML Pool. And our property deductible has increased to \$500 from \$250.
